Is Fine Tuning the Result of "Chance"?



Chance *¥* Explanation



Chance = "I Don't Know"

"It's just a coincidence."



"How much chance can we buy in scientific explanation? One measure of what is involved can be given in terms of coin flipping: odds of 10^{120} to 1 is like getting heads no fewer than four hundred times in a row. If the existence of life in the universe is completely independent of the big fix mechanism - if it's just a coincidence then those are the odds against our being here. That level of flukiness seems too much to swallow."

"To defeat the fine-tuning argument, I do not have to give a reason why each parameter has the value it does, I must only show that life could be plausible under a wide range of parameters."
