God is Personal: Nature of Persons to Communicate: Reasonable

**Still a Gracious Choice God Made** 

**"The infinite personal God is there, but also he is not silent; that changes the whole world"** (xxviii, p 276, Complete Works, Francis Schaeffer Vol. 1).

GOD HAS SPOKEN: Psalm 50:3 "Our God approaches and he is not silent" (NLT).

Thus Says the Lord-over 400 times in OT

David: "The Spirit of the Lord spoke through me; his word was on my tongue" (2 Sam.23:2).

Jeremiah: (God speaking) "I am about to set my words on fire in your mouth" (Jer. 5:14a).

**Peter:** "Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation of things. For prophecy never had its origin in the human will, but prophets, though human, spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit" (2 Pet. 1:20-21).

Legitimate Question: How do we know this Communication, the Bible, is From God and Not Man-made?

Predictive Prophecy, Unity of Bible, Accurate Historical Document...

Who is God to me? What's our relationship like? Father/Adopted Child Rom. 8:15, Gal. 4:5

Who am I? Creature but Masterpiece (Poema) Eph. 2:10, Sinner/Saint

What does God think of me? Psalm 139, He sees (Hagar Gen. 16:13), Hears (Ishamel Gen.

21:17)

Grand Canyon Example: "The Lord directs the steps of the godly. He delights in every detail of their lives. Though they stumble, they will never fall, or the Lord holds them by the hand" (**Ps. 37:23-24 NLT**).

What is the meaning/purpose of my life? Love, Serve and Glorify God (Luke 10:27, I Pet. 4:11) Ambassadors (2 Cor. 5:20).

What's my destiny after this life? Be with Christ which is better by far (Phil. 1:23).

#### WHY DOES HIS SPEAKING MATTER? Generally

God's Word is Unlike Any Human's Word

Not thinking rightly if low appreciation of God's Word: Psalm 19:7-11, Psalm 119

Why does his speaking matter *for us personally*? REAL TWO WAY RELATIONSHIP

**Always Can Hear From God:** 

**Direct Access:** 

Has Power to Change Us: I Thess. 2:13

Experiential Knowledge: Coincidental timing?

**Certainty/Security:** And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life. <sup>13</sup> I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that *you may know* that *you have eternal life*. **I John 5:11-13** 

Why does his speaking matter for evangelism?

Common Conversation Stopper: Just your opinion unless God has spoken

Something worthwhile to say:

Answers the Agnostic: One who says we can't/don't know

Answers the Relativist: No absolute truth

Answers the Deist: Creator who does not intervene

Why does his speaking matter for teaching?

**Stay closely in his Word:** Deut. 4:2, 5:32, 12:32, 17:11,20, 28:14, Josh:1:7, 23:6, Prov. 30:6, I Cor. 4:6, Rev. 22:18.

Addresses Pride/Anxiety/Inadequacy: God's Word has Power Not Us: Isa. 55:11

Listen to/for God: Deut. 17:18-20

**STUDY/Meditate**

Give it away literally
